Brief Report on Gandhi Jayanthi- Swachhata Hi Seva Andolan-2024

The 5/27 NCC Coy organized Swachhata Hi Seva Andolan on the special occasion of Gandhi Jayanti 02.10.2024 at 8.30 am (0830 hour). The chief guest of the function was Dr.Y. K. Virupakshappa, Head Department of History during his speech Mahatma Gandhi, a world-known name and an inspiring leader. This is the 155th birth anniversary of Gandhi and another year to remember his contributions. After returning to India in 1915, Gandhi started fighting against British rule. His first major movement was the Champaran Satyagraha, which started in 1917. Here he raised his voice against the British after seeing the plight of the farmers. After this, in 1920 he started the Non-Cooperation Movement, in which people were appealed to do non-cooperation against the British rule. In 1930, Gandhi ji did the Dandi March, in which he protested against the salt law. This march started on 12 March 1930 and lasted for 24 days. This event created awareness across the country against the British government. In 1942, Gandhi ji led the Quit India Movement, in which he clearly said that now the British should leave India. This movement proved to be the last step towards the independence of India. His powerful slogan, "Jai Jawan, Jai Kisan," inspired the nation to value both soldiers and farmers. And Shastri Ji taken great and fearless decision at some critical situation in India. Also Shastri Ji was a man of action, known for his humility and selfless service. His leadership showed that greatness lies in living a life of truth and responsibility. Further Dr. M.M. Akki, Head of the Department of History in his speech said Gandhi ji's life was completely based on non-violence and truth. He never resorted to violence in his life and always walked on the path of truth. He believed that any problem or conflict can be solved without violence, if people move forward with truth and patience. His famous line was: "Give me blood, I will give you freedom," which he said to inspire the youth of India. The president of the function Shri S. A. Thippesh, Principal delivered presidential remarks in his presidential remarks said that today, on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, we should pledge to follow his ideals. Only by following the path of truth and non-violence can we build a better society. Let us all together contribute to building the India of Gandhi's dreams.
